Dear Student,

You are registered for course # 3005-145, "East Meets West: Chinese and Watercolor Painting" with Lian Zhen on July 20 - 25, 2008.

Faculty asks that you bring the following supplies with you:

**Watercolor Materials:**

Brushes:

- ✓ "Round" brushes: No. 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8
- ✓ Flat brushes: 1/4" 1/2", 1" and 1-1/2"

Colors (in tubes, any brand):

- ✓ Antwerp Blue or Prussian Blue
- ✓ Azo Yellow Medium (Van Gogh) or Permanent Yellow Lemon (HWC)
- ✓ Permanent Red Deep (Van Gogh) or Permanent Red (HWC)

Paper:

- ✓ Arches, 140lb. Cold press 22" x 30", three sheets

Palette:

- ✓ One large palette such as John Pike Watercolor

Masking Fluid:

- ✓ A small bottle of art masking fluid less than 2 years old (with color).

Other:

- ✓ One gator board or plywood board for taping down the watercolor paper (half sheet)
- ✓ Three small dishes for making color liquids
- ✓ A roll of masking tape or clear packing tape
- ✓ A hair dryer
- ✓ A medium-sized water sprayer
- ✓ An apron
- ✓ Five (5) sheets of tracing paper (about 15" x 21"0)
- ✓ A pair of scissors
- ✓ A teaspoon of table salt
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Erasers
- ✓ Roll of white color paper towel

The faculty will also supply additional materials not listed above. Once class has begun, If you should choose to transfer out of this course, the materials fee of \$45 that you had paid upon registration is non-refundable.
